Why is UCWB measuring "what matters" to our customers?

Who can be involved and how will you be selected?

We are looking for a group of customers to help us understand your experiences of UCWB, and to make sure we only measure what's relevant and important to you.

We are interested to hear from as many of our customers as possible, but we also are looking to hear from customers who have particular lived experience, such as:

- People from a culturally diverse background
- Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people
- Children, young people their families and carers
- People over 65 years old
- People who are survivors of family and domestic violence
- People who have experienced financial insecurity
- People who have experienced mental health concerns.

How will it work?

Once we receive your "registration of interest" and contact details, we will contact you to discuss the different ways that you can be involved based on the experiences you have had and why type of involvement would suit you best.



The co-design process will occur between December 2023 - June 2024. During this time you may be invited to participate in different activities such as:

- Focus groups
- Workshops
- One-on-one interviews
- Online surveys.

What do I get for participating?

Participation in the project is voluntary and will in no way impact your service delivery. You will receive a gift voucher for your involvement. If you need assistance to attend any of the project activities you are invited to, we will support you as much as possible. Please let us know your needs when we contact you.

How will you manage my personal information?
